WHAT YOU CAN DO

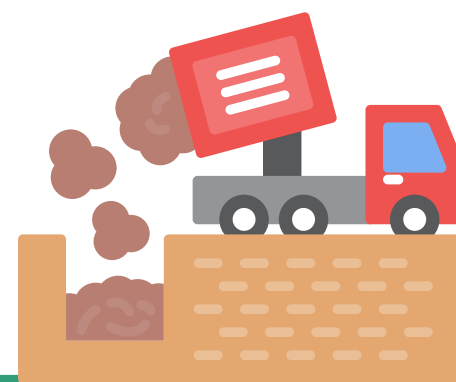
SEGREGATE WASTE AT THE SOURCE

Use color-coded bins correctly.



SWITCH TO SAFE DISPOSAL METHODS

Use autoclaves, microwaving, chemical disinfection, and landfilling for infectious waste.



EDUCATE AND ENGAGE

Share messages of safe medical waste handling through talks, posters, green groups, and creative contests like murals, skits, or videos.



ADVOCATE FOR CHANGE

Push for facility-level policies that ban incineration.
